OXFORDSHIRE AREA 37 SHOW 2011

Rules and Regulations

- 1 All exhibitors enter at their own risk. The Committee, Show Organisers, their Employees, Officials or Volunteers cannot be held responsible for any accidents, injury, damage, theft or illness howsoever caused to horses, riders, owners, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. It is a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising from any such incident.
- 2 The Show Organisers retain as their absolute discretion the right to decline or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or return any entry fee without being required to assign reason or being liable for any compensation.
- 3 All classes are run under the rules and regulations of British Showjumping.
- 4 All riders whilst mounted must wear hard hats to conform to the latest British Safety Standards as per British Showjumping rules.
- 5 Dogs are permitted in the lorry park and car park only. They must be kept on a lead and under control at all times. Any person failing to control their dog/s may be asked to leave the showground.
- 6 Warm up is restricted to the specified areas only.
- 7 All exhibitors must be correctly dressed when walking the course and all exhibitors must attend any prize giving mounted. Failure to do so may result in prize money being withheld as per rule 76.6.1.
- 8 The Show Organisers and Judges decisions are final.
- 9 The Organisers reserve the right to alter and/or cancel classes with prior permission from BS, or refuse entries without reason.
- 10 Entries will only be accepted with payment or open cheque.
- 11 British Showjumping Rule 82.21: No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
- 12 The expenses of any farrier or veterinary services rendered on the showground must be borne by the competitor or owner of the animal.
- 13 Entries for all classes, unless pre-entry, will close half an hour after the start of each class.
- 14 Any objections should be submitted to the secretary within 30 minutes immediately following the class along with a deposit of £100 which will be returnable if the objection is upheld.

Competitors in the second round will start in reverse order of merit or the slowest four faulter will go first, the fastest clear to go last. If necessary those who do not reach the second round, faults and time in the first round will determine placings, however he/she will be placed after those who compete in round two. If a competitor withdraws from the second round he/she will not be replaced and he/she will receive the placing from the first round.
