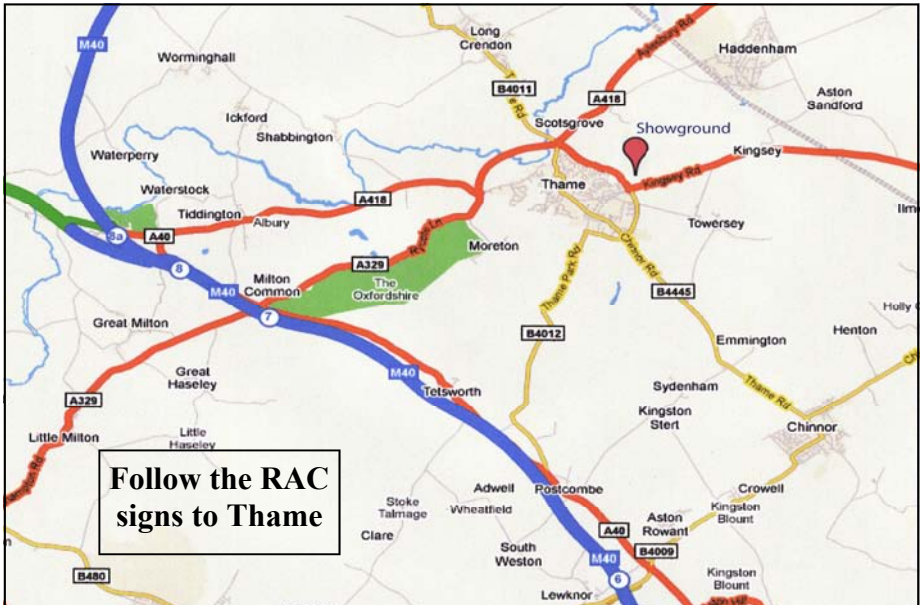

2. In all jumping classes entries will be limited as stated in Main Ring.
3. Application for refunds must be made before the day of the Show in accordance with 'British Showjumping' Rule 79.
4. In the event of insufficient starters lower prizes may be withheld in accordance with 'British Showjumping' Rule 76.6.
5. Attention is drawn to 'British Showjumping' Rule 101 concerning protective headgear and dress.
6. Attention is drawn to 'British Showjumping' Rule 82.21 concerning stallions and Rule 102.12.

From the South (London): M40 J6 (Tetsworth) or J7 (Milton Common)

From the West: M4 J13 onto A34. Exit A34 at Oxford South Ring Road. Follow Ring Road signed A40/M40 London. Exit at A40, stay on A40 to A418 signed Thame/Aylesbury.

From the North (Birmingham): M40 J8a (Wheatley Services) Note: No exit J7 from the North.

From the East: A418 from Aylesbury
